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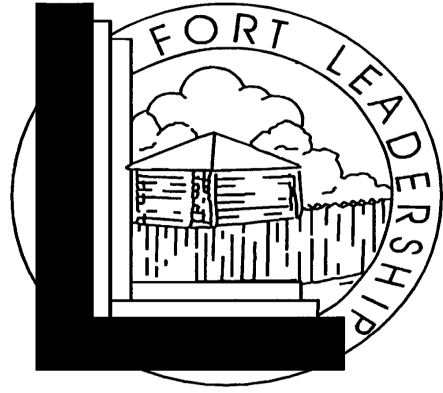

What is Project LEAD?

Project LEAD was created to seek emerging leaders and prepare them for positions of public leadership. This preparation will allow for the development of well-informed and highly-motivated leaders that are qualified to assume present and future leadership roles in the Fort Atkinson area.

Through a series of monthly training sessions, Project LEAD emphasizes leadership concepts and community needs.

Each session will feature local leaders and specialists in various forums, including group discussions, question and answer sessions, and tours throughout the community.

Project LEAD will require a commitment of one half-day each month from September through May, a one day weekend retreat and a sponsorship cost of \$175.00 for the total program.
